



PELICAN POINT

2017 MGA ROUND ROBIN GOLF TOURNAMENT SATURDAY, MARCH 25th & SUNDAY, MARCH 26th

FORMAT: The format for this event will be a match play handicap tournament whereby each team will play five (5) nine-hole matches within their flight.

*****Each team will play three (3) matches on Saturday and three (2) matches on Sunday. Any team with a “Bye” will play four matches.**

FLIGHT: Each flight will consist of six (6) teams, based on total team handicap index. There is a maximum 8 stroke difference between two partners handicap. Any team that exceeds the 8 stroke difference between handicaps will be adjusted for flights and matches.

SCORING: Each nine-hole match is worth ten (10) points. Each hole won, on a net basis is worth one (1) point. Each hole halved is worth one-half (1/2) point to each team. The team scoring the most points in each match will receive one (1) “bonus” point. If the match ends in a tie, the teams will split the “bonus” point and each team will receive one-half (1/2) point. **Please remember that each match will be played for the entire nine holes. When a team has been closed out, the remaining holes are still worth one (1) point each. At least one member of each team must hole out on each hole.**

The team that accumulates the most total points using this scoring system will be declared the winner of each flight. You are only competing against the other teams in your flight, not the entire tournament field.

HANDICAP/STROKE ALLOCATION: The maximum handicap is 25. Each nine-hole match will be played BEST BALL using 100% HANDICAP. The lowest handicap player in the group will play “Scratch”, or a 0 handicap. The others players in the group will be given the difference in their handicaps versus the scratch players original handicap. Example – four players have the following nine-hole handicaps.

Player #1 – 5 handicap

Player #2 – 7 handicap

Player #3 – 8 handicap

Player #4 – 9 handicap

In this match, player #1 would play to “Scratch” or a 0 handicap. Player #2 would receive two (2) strokes, player #3 would receive three (3) strokes, and player #4 would receive four (4) strokes. These strokes will be allocated on the basis of the scorecard allocation for each flight. **Note:** Odd handicapped holes are on the front nine. Players will be given different handicap allocations for each match, depending on the lowest player’s handicap in that match and which 9 holes they play.

Champions Shoot-out: Immediately following the fifth round match on Sunday, all flight winners will compete in a voluntary shootout format to determine the 2017 MGA Round Robin Champions. The shootout will be a best ball format that will begin on hole #10 and continue on the back nine until only one team remains. One team will be eliminated on each hole either by score or by chip-off. Handicap and stroke allocation will be based on Hole Handicap and **NOT** as the tournament rounds. In the event of a tie that will result in a chip-off, both team members will compete with the closest to the hole winning and advancing to the next hole. Entry fee for this event will be \$50.00 per team cash only, winners take all. This is a voluntary shoot-out. If your team decides not to participate, the second place in your flight will be next.

ENTRY FEE: **\$90.00 per person** (plus applicable cart fee each day).
(As with all MGA events, \$15.00 of the entry fee goes toward the Pelican Cup fund; \$10.00 towards food (Fried Fish, Coleslaw, and French Fries) and \$65.00 goes toward prizes paid in the form of Golf Shop credit). **MULLIGANS: Only one mulligan may be used during each 9-hole match.**

TEE OF PLAY: All play will be from the Gold Tees

PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place teams in each flight in the form of golf shop credit.

The first 18 Teams that sign up for the event are guaranteed to play. Anyone after that will be put on a waiting list. Anyone who voluntarily withdraws from the tournament will not receive Pelican Point Cups and will be subject to additional disciplinary actions by the MGA Committee.
